**ACTIVITY DETAILS**

On September 10, 2003, Dr. Robert Johnson from ATSDR's Division of Health Education and Promotion (DHEP) participated in a symposium at California State University, Monterey Bay (CSUMB). The symposium was targeted to university students, staff and faculty to inform them about the Fort Ord prescribed burns and the opportunity for relocation. Dr. Johnson co-presented with Dr. Jim Creighton who was representing Fort Ord. Faculty from CSUMB facilitated the meeting. This collaboration was highly successful with support from ATSDR, Fort Ord, and CSUMB. Representatives from EPA, BLM, and the Forest Service were available to address questions from the audience. Approximately 50 people attended the symposium.

ATSDR/DHEP also partnered with the American Lung Association of the Central Coast (ALA) to develop information packets to underserved populations in the areas surrounding Fort Ord. Information was provided on the prescribed burn program, recommendations for reducing exposure to smoke, and information on the relocation program. The materials were available in both English and Spanish. Approximately 3500 documents were provided to ALA and were distributed through the ALA's outreach programs.

On September 9-12, 2003, Dr. Robert H. Johnson, from the ATSDR Division of Health Education and Promotion (DHEP) conducted a site visit to the Fort Ord site, to participate in a symposium regarding the site at the California State University Monterey Bay (CSUMB). The symposium brought together experts from the US Army and their contractors, California EPA and other local and state environmental agencies, the Ord Military Community Fire Department, the Bureau of Land Management, the US Army Corps of Engineers, the Naval Postgraduate School, and faculty and students at CSUMB. During the symposium, Dr. Johnson presented information on community stress issues and possible health effects associated with smoke and provided advice on taking environmental exposure histories. Approximately 50 individuals attended the symposium. Additionally, Dr. Johnson was available to provide health education to local health care providers concerning the proposed burns planned for the site and the potential health effects associated with smoke.

On September 25 and 26, 2003, Yolonda Freeman and Maria Teran-McIver conducted the training course "Introduction to Environmental Health" at the University of Guam. The goal of the training was to develop the knowledge, skills, and abilities of health care providers, and health educators to assess, plan, and intervene appropriately in environmental health issues occurring in their areas of practice and in the populations they serve. The topics that were covered in the training included the role of nurses in environmental health, environmental health/exposure pathways, toxicology, community concerns, taking an exposure history, risk communication and accessing environmental health information. The participants received continuing education credits for participating in the training. Twenty eight participants attended the two days of training. Of the twenty-eight participants, seventeen were nurses.

On September 26, 2003, Yolonda Freeman and Maria Teran-McIver presented information on taking an exposure history, toxicology and risk communication at the grand rounds held at Guam Memorial Hospital. The hospital provided continuing education credits for the physicians attending the grand rounds. Fifteen physicians attended the grand rounds sessions.
